## Geography Fieldwork Trip to the River Trym – Tuesday 16th January 2024

Year 3 will be visiting several points along the River Trym (The River Trym is only 4.5 miles long and the points where we will be carrying out our field work will not come higher than a welly and are not fast moving) as part of our connected curriculum work on Rivers and will also allow us to review our knowledge of erosion from our work on rocks. The children will have time to complete fieldwork at various points along the river as well as take photos of the key features along its course.

This trip is during the school day, the coach will leave at 9.30am and return to school before the end of the school day.

All children will need to wear wellingtons, a hat, gloves, a waterproof coat and warm sensible clothing (no jeans). Please also provide your child with a spare set of clothing in a bag in case they get wet. Children will need a packed lunch and water bottle. I will provide them with a hot drink to have with their lunch.

We appreciate that everyone is experiencing financial pressures at the moment, so we are working to ensure that these experiences are affordable for all children. Therefore, where possible we are subsiding school trips, however if we do not receive sufficient voluntary contributions, this trip will not be able to go ahead.
